^{*} As per Official Gazette post, President Benigno S. Aquino III signed Proclamation No. 84 entitled DECLARING THE REGULAR HOLIDAYS, SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAYS, AND SPECIAL HOLIDAY (FOR ALL SCHOOLS) FOR THE YEAR 2011.

According to the **Proclamation No. 84,** the Philippines 2011 holidays are categorized into three: Regular Holidays, Special Non-Working Days and Special Holidays (for all schools).

The proclamation also has provisions for the national holidays in observance of **Eid'l Fitr** and **Eidul Adha**, but the exact dates are still to be determined in accordance with the Islamic calendar.

^aFor the Summer session, 3-unit lecture classes meet two (2) hours daily, Monday to Friday, for 24 class days.
