Financial Assistance Program for UP Diliman and UP Visayas Tacloban Students Affected by Typhoon Yolanda

To date, there are at least 40 UP Visayas Tacloban students who have crossregistered at the UP Virata School of Business. In addition, there are three of UP Diliman Virata School of Business students from Samar and Leyte areas whose families were affected by Typhoon Yolanda.

The University of the Philippines has waived the tuition fee of affected UP Diliman and Tacloban students during the 2nd semester, AY 2013-14. It has also rebracketed the students to E2 that allows the affected students to receive P2,000 allowance per month per student.

We can help by giving supplemental living expenses (board and lodging, transportation, and other expenses) to the cross registrants in UP VSB. We suggest a supplement of P1,000 per student per month. Each affected student will have to apply for assistance and declare what other forms of assistance she/he is receiving.
