200 UPCAT Qualifiers to UP Virata School of Business

In August 2015 the UP Virata School of Business (VSB) welcomes 200 freshmen into its two undergraduate programs. Last August 2014, 88,525 high school seniors took the UP College Admission Test in various testing centers around the country. Of the total examinees, 58,209 applied to UP Diliman.

VSB's Bachelor of Science in Business Administration and Accountancy (BSBAA) program received the most number of 1st choice applicants, 9,141 for its 100 available slots. Its selectivity ratio (acceptance rate) or the number of final course qualifiers to number of 1st choice applicants is 1.09%. BSBAA's UP System qualifiers numbered 1,790. This means 1,690 other BSBAA applicants qualified to UP but will have to settle to their second degree program choice or to any other degree program with available slots.

The Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (BSBA) program received the 3rd most number of 1st choice applicants of 3,618 for its 100 available slots. Its selectivity ratio is 2.76%. BSBA's UP System qualifiers numbered 326. There are 226 other BSBA UP System qualifiers who could no longer be accommodated in the BSBA program.

The attractiveness of VSB's undergraduate programs continues after first year of studies when about 400 shiftees from UP's other degree programs apply to be admitted to VSB every year.
