<sup>a</sup>For the Summer session, 3-unit lecture classes meet two (2) hours daily, Monday to Friday, for 24 class days.

<sup>b</sup>For transferees from schools outside the UP system only; students from other CU should check earlier deadlines set by the college where they intend to transfer.

\* Per OSU, BOR Meetings are usually held every last Thursday of the month. However, the BOR Chair or UP President may ask for a re-scheduling of the said meeting.

\*\* For December, the BOR Meeting is usually held on the same day as the Lantern Parade.

+ As per Official Gazette post, President Benigno S. Aquino III signed Proclamation No. 295 entitled DECLARING THE REGULAR HOLIDAYS, SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAYS, AND SPECIAL HOLIDAY (FOR ALL SCHOOLS) FOR THE YEAR 2012.

According to the Proclamation No.295, the Philippines 2012 holidays are categorized into three: Regular Holidays, Special Non-Working Days and Special Holiday (for all schools).

The proclamation also has provisions for the national holidays in observance of Eid'l Fitr and Eid ul Adha, but the exact dates are still to be determined in accordance with the Islamic calendar.
