
Adding Mathematical Equations


This page walks you through the steps in adding mathematical expressions on UVLe.

Enable Editing and Add a Resource




Enable editing by clicking on (1) "Turn editing on" and (2) Add a resource. Mathematical expressions can be added at least through Label or through a Page. **Label** is used when you want to display the equation right on the main page. Use **Page** if you want to add a separate, more elaborate page with mathematical expressions.

■Adding a new Page



In **Adding a new Page**, the **Name** of the page is required. Click on **DragMath Equation Editor** icon to start writing your equation on UVLe. The Editor requires you to install Java (preferably the most recent version) in your computer.

Typing in a mathematical expression using the DragMath Equation Editor



The DragMath Equation Editor has tabs that group expressions into cluster. Once a tab is chosen, it will displate symbols and templates that can be dragged into the text.

Once the equation is written, click on **Insert**. The **code** of the mathematical expression will then be displayed in the Page content. Save the page when done.
